## Filing period Feb. 15-18 for City Council seats

Are you interested in representing your Warr Acres neighbors? Filing period is Feb. 15-18, 2005, and requires a "Declaration of Candidacy" filed with the Oklahoma County Election Board, 4201 N. Lincoln Blvd. A copy of that may be taken to the City Clerk to serve as a sworn statement of candidacy. The primary election for Mayor and City Council is the third Tuesday in March (March 15), and general election the first Tuesday in April (April 5).
